

Historical Dates and Revitalization Timeline

1902	First missionary Rev. Tommie Titcombe settles in the region
1925	Maternity and clinic established
1952	Egbe Hospital founded by Dr. and Mrs. Campion, missionaries with SIM
1955	School of Nursing established; first one in Kogi State
1965	Modern operating theatre constructed
1970	Eye Care Centre opened
1971	New Maternity Building built
1976	SIM properties transferred to ECWA; Egbe Hospital renamed to ECWA Hospital Egbe
1982	Hospital accredited by the National Postgraduate Medical College of Nigeria for Family Medicine Residency
2002	Hospital celebrates 50 th Anniversary
2006	ECWA School of Nursing and ECWA School of Midwifery fully accredited by Nursing and Midwifery Council of Nigeria
2008	Seed planted by community members and hospital staff to restore Egbe Hospital
2009	Discovery Team conducts feasibility study to assess whether to revitalize the hospital
2010	Project becomes official SIM project with SP/WMM and ECWA as partners
2011	Samaritan's Purse construction and volunteer managers arrive from USA to begin construction
2012	Arrival of SIM missionary Medical Director/Family Medicine physician and SP construction foreman; 60 th Year Anniversary Celebration of the hospital; re-accreditation by the National Postgraduate Medical College of Nigeria
2013	Arrival of SIM maintenance manager; Construction of missionary and resident doctor homes, building water reservoir and filtration systems, re-wiring electric grid on compound, construction of OPD and medical buildings; re-accreditation by the West African College of Physicians
2014	Arrival of SP Medical Director/General Surgeon, Director of Administration; WMM post resident physician and SIM family physician; Dedication and Commissioning of 12,000 sq. ft. main hospital .
2015	Complete building projects; focus on recruiting Nigerians and missionaries; document and implement best practices; SIM Board of Governors extend project to 2019
2016-17	Capital development, human resources leadership, training to ensure sustainability
2018-19	Focus on maintenance and program evaluation to ensure continuity of progress with leadership at the hospital
